### Information about cookies

At Alligo, we use cookies. According to the Swedish Act on Electronic Communication (2003:389), everyone who visits a website that uses cookies must be informed that the website contains cookies and of the purpose for which they are used. ### What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that contain information and are stored on your computer.

There are two types of cookies: persistent cookies and session cookies. Persistent cookies remain on a user's computer until the user removes them or until the expiry date set for the cookie has passed and the user returns to [www.alligo.com](http://www.alligo.com). Some persistent cookies can be used to track a user's visits to various websites. Session cookies do not have an expiry date and are temporarily stored on a user's computer while the user visits [www.alligo.com](http://www.alligo.com). When the user closes his or her browser, the session cookies disappear.

### How can visitors manage their cookies?

Users may choose if and to what extent cookies are to be saved on their computers. This can be done by altering the settings of your browser. Users can also use their browser settings to erase previously stored cookies.
